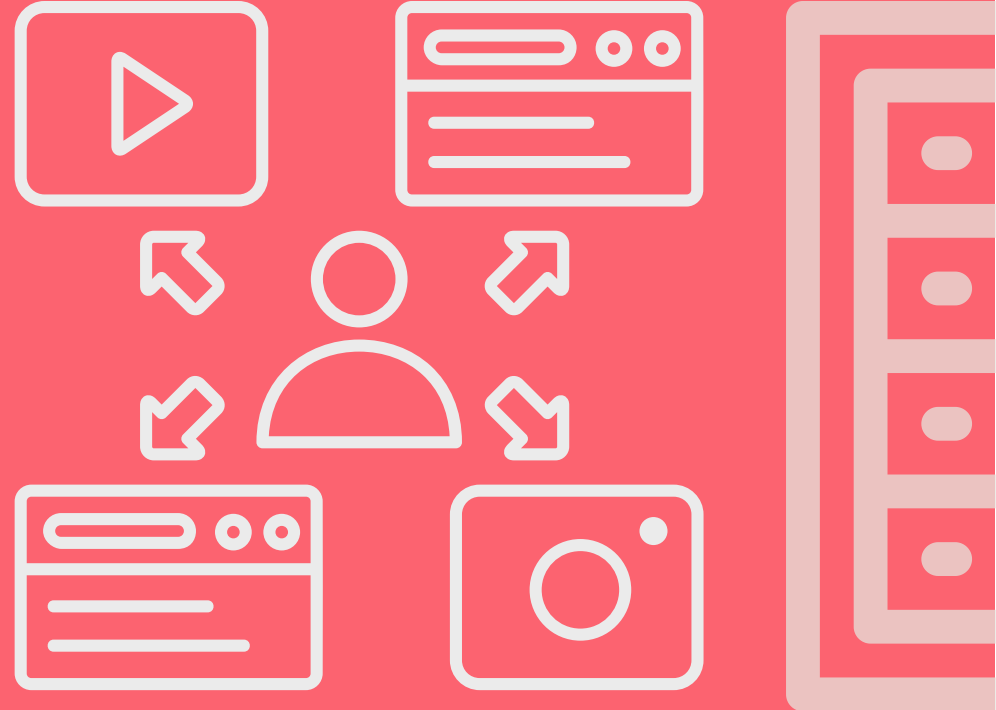


## Empowering Women to Take Action

### Take the Pledge for Obesity Care Coverage



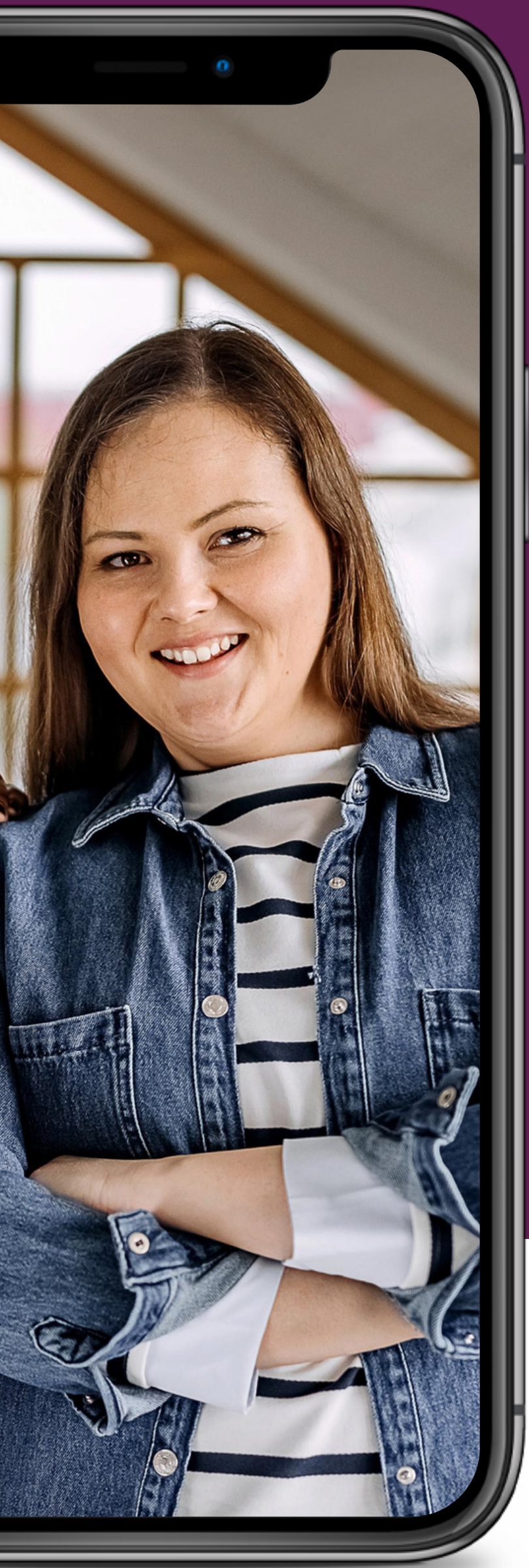
### Show your support for obesity care coverage by pledging to:

## Talk to Your Employer About Obesity Care Insurance Coverage

Many health insurance plans include barriers that place the full range of obesity care options, particularly medications, out of reach for many women. Less than half of employers currently cover or are considering covering the latest generation of anti-obesity medications. Use HealthyWomen's template letter to ask your employer for obesity care coverage.

## Urge Your Legislators to Support the Treat and Reduce Obesity Act!

The Treat and Reduce Obesity Act (TROA) is bipartisan legislation that would provide Medicare beneficiaries with access to anti-obesity medications.

State Medicaid programs vary in their coverage options, with only 16 states providing coverage for anti-obesity or weight-loss medications.

Legislators want to know how obesity-related barriers have impacted you to help them better understand the need for greater access to critical obesity care options.
