
women in **Illinois** deserve coverage for obesity care



obesity is a chronic disease impacting women across Illinois



In Illinois, obesity impacts:1







Obesity is linked to over 200 other chronic health complications including breast and ovarian cancers and fertility challenges.²



Women living with obesity earn 9% less than women without obesity.3

Health insurance barriers place obesity care options, especially medications, out of reach for many women in Illinois.



Only 13% of Illinoisans have health insurance plans that cover obesity medications.4



Illinois Medicaid does not cover obesity medications.4

In addition to obesity medications, evidencebased, comprehensive obesity care includes:5

- Nutrition services
- Intensive behavioral therapy
- Weight-loss surgery
- Physical activity

obesity has a significant financial impact on the state of Illinois



In 2022, the disease:



Reduced economic activity in Illinois by \$17.6 billion⁶



Increased Illinois employers' healthcare costs by \$2.1 billion⁶

Obesity care should be covered in Illinois just like care for other chronic diseases—it's only fair. **Let's work together** to ensure everybody is covered in Illinois.
